

# My College Timeline

## Fall of Senior Year

- **Take the ACT test** --- apply online at [www.actstudent.org/start](http://www.actstudent.org/start)

- If you will need letters of recommendations start thinking about it now.
- Check the Counselor's Corner board regularly.
- Start sending in applications for admission to colleges you are considering.
- Apply for scholarships.
- Plan to attend financial aid meeting at HHS, September 21st, at 6:00 pm with your parents.
- In October, apply online for the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov) to apply for federal financial aid.
- Schedule a campus visit and meet with academic advisors, get a list of classes for your major, and tour the campus.
- Visit with admissions representatives when they visit our high school. You will need to sign up with Mr. Smith to be excused from class.
- Check with Mr. Smith for information about local scholarships and special events being held on college campuses. (example – Senior Days)
- Start thinking about housing and send in applications for housing if necessary.
- KU and K-State deadlines for scholarships are November 1.

## Spring of Senior year

- Begin filling out residence hall housing contracts.
- Keep checking with Mr. Smith about special events and scholarships.
- Washburn University deadline for scholarships is February 15.
- Check with other colleges to see their scholarship deadlines.
- In late spring, watch for information about financial aid awards and Freshman Orientation and Enrollment.
